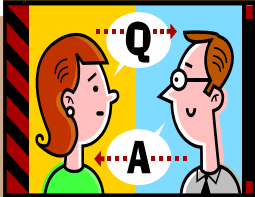

A Habitat ReStore is a facility that supports the

services provided by its local Habitat for Humanity affiliate.

The income generated from the project goes specifically toward expanding the building program of the local Habitat affiliate.

ReStores recycle overstocked, discontinued, new and used building materials and other household items donated by manufacturers, stores, contractors and individuals. These donated items are sold to the public or used in construction of Habitat houses.

All revenue from sales goes to the local affiliate in support of its building program.

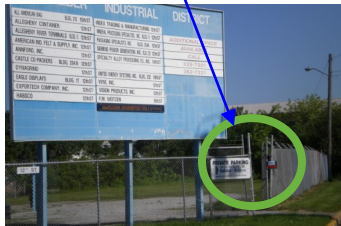

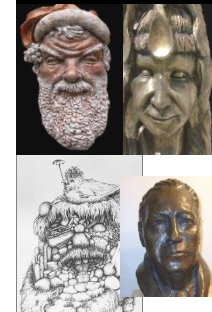
So far - no tickets! It is a warehouse, but it is kept clean and things are arranged for easy viewing.

Rich then went to Portland School of Fine and Applied Art where he was introduced to sculpture and lithography, continuing studies under John Ventiniglia and lithography with John Gardner. After three years in Portland, Maine, he returned to Pittsburgh to study Portrait Sculpture with Eugene Gittings at the Pittsburgh Center for the Arts.
