Richard Michaux was born and raised in Pittsburgh, PA. He first studied painting and drawing with Mr. Hurbert in high school.

Pursuing his career, Richard went to Ivy School of Professional Art in downtown Pittsburgh. Private lessons of drawing and painting with Odel Abney piqued his interest to continue his career.

Rich then went to Portland School of Fine and Applied Art where he was introduced to sculpture and lithography, continuing studies under John Ventiniglia and lithography with John Gardner.

After three years in Portland, Maine, he returned to Pittsburgh to study Portrait Sculpture with Eugene Gittings at the Pittsburgh Center for the Arts.

Today he continues his creative work through the eyes of the private sector.
